

## DATA PROTECTION DECLARATION

### 1) Introduction and Contact Details of the Controller

1.1 We are pleased that you are visiting our website and thank you for your interest. Below, we inform you about the handling of your personal data when using our website. Personal data means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person.

1.2 The controller for data processing on this website within the meaning of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is:

The controller is the natural or legal person who alone or jointly with others determines the purposes and means of the processing of personal data.

### 2) Data Collection When Visiting Our Website

2.1 If you use our website purely for informational purposes – i.e. without registering or otherwise providing us with information – we only collect the data that your browser transmits to our server (so-called “server log files”). When you access our website, we collect the following data, which is technically necessary to display the website to you:

- Visited website
- Date and time of access
- Amount of data transferred (in bytes)
- Referring URL (the page you came from)
- Browser used
- Operating system used
- IP address (possibly in anonymised form)

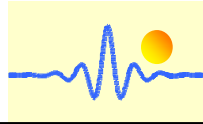
Processing is carried out in accordance with Art. 6 (1) lit. f GDPR based on our legitimate interest in improving the stability and functionality of our website. This data is not passed on or otherwise used. However, we reserve the right to retrospectively check the server log files if there are concrete indications of unlawful use.

2.2 This website uses SSL or TLS encryption for security reasons and to protect the transmission of personal data and other confidential content (e.g., orders or enquiries to the controller). You can recognize an encrypted connection by the “https://” prefix and the lock symbol in your browser’s address bar.

### 3) Hosting & Content Delivery Network (CDN)

We use a service provider to host our website and deliver its content, who provides their services either directly or via selected subcontractors exclusively on servers located within the European Union.

All data collected on our website is processed on these servers.

We have concluded a data processing agreement (DPA) with the provider to ensure the protection of our website visitors' data and to prohibit unauthorised disclosure to third parties.

### 4) Contacting Us

When contacting us (e.g., via contact form or email), personal data is collected. The data collected through the contact form is visible from the form itself. This data is stored and used exclusively for the purpose of responding to your request and for the related technical administration.

The legal basis for processing is our legitimate interest in responding to your request in accordance with Art. 6 (1) lit. f GDPR. If your contact is aimed at concluding a contract, then Art. 6 (1) lit. b GDPR serves as an additional legal basis.

Your data will be deleted once your request has been fully processed, provided there are no statutory retention obligations.

### 5) Website Features

#### 5.1 Google Maps

This website uses the Google Maps API provided by:

**Google Ireland Limited, Gordon House, 4 Barrow St, Dublin, D04 E5W5, Ireland (“Google”).**

Google Maps is a web service for displaying interactive maps to visually present geographic information. Using this service helps display our location and makes navigation easier.

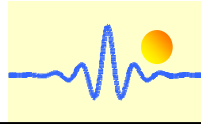
When accessing subpages containing Google Maps, information about your use of our website (e.g. your IP address) is transferred to and stored on Google servers, which may also include servers of Google LLC in the USA. This occurs regardless of whether you are logged into a Google account. If logged in, the data is directly associated with your Google profile. To prevent this, log out of your Google account before activating the map.

Data collection and analysis are carried out in accordance with Art. 6 (1) lit. f GDPR based on Google's legitimate interest in displaying personalised advertising, market research, and demand-oriented design of Google services.

You have the right to object to the creation of these user profiles; please contact Google to exercise this right.

If you do not agree to data transfer to Google, you can disable the Google Maps web service by disabling JavaScript in your browser. In that case, the map function will not be usable.

Where legally required, we obtain your consent in accordance with Art. 6 (1) lit. a GDPR prior to such processing. You may withdraw your consent at any time with future effect. To do so, follow the described objection options.

Google participates in the EU-U.S. Data Privacy Framework, which ensures compliance with the European level of data protection based on a European Commission adequacy decision.

## **5.2 Applications via Email**

We list current job openings in a separate section on our website. Interested candidates may apply via email to the contact address provided.

Applicants must provide all personal data required for a fair and informed assessment, including general data (e.g. name, address, contact details), qualification evidence, and, where applicable, health-related information. Details are outlined in the job postings.

Applications are processed solely for the purpose of managing the application process. For any queries, we may contact the applicant via email or telephone.

Processing is based on Art. 6 (1) lit. b GDPR and § 26 (1) BDSG, as the application process constitutes steps toward entering into an employment contract.

If special categories of personal data are collected under Art. 9 (1) GDPR (e.g., health data), processing is based on Art. 9 (2) lit. b GDPR to exercise rights or comply with obligations under employment and social security law.

Alternatively, Art. 9 (2) lit. h GDPR may apply, if data is processed for preventive or occupational medicine, assessment of work capacity, medical diagnosis, or social/health care system management.

If an applicant is not selected or withdraws their application, all submitted data and email correspondence will be deleted within six months after notification. This retention period is based on our legitimate interest in addressing any follow-up questions and in fulfilling potential obligations under equal treatment legislation.

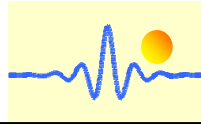
If the application is successful, data will be processed for employment purposes under Art. 6 (1) lit. b GDPR in conjunction with § 26 (1) BDSG.

## **6) Rights of the Data Subject**

6.1 You have the following rights regarding the processing of your personal data (subject to the respective legal requirements):

- Right of access (Art. 15 GDPR)
- Right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR)
- Right to erasure (Art. 17 GDPR)
- Right to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR)
- Right to notification (Art. 19 GDPR)
- Right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR)
- Right to withdraw consent (Art. 7 (3) GDPR)



- Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR)

## 6.2 RIGHT TO OBJECT

IF WE PROCESS YOUR PERSONAL DATA ON THE BASIS OF OUR LEGITIMATE INTERESTS (PURSUANT TO ART. 6 (1) LIT. F GDPR), YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO OBJECT TO THIS PROCESSING AT ANY TIME ON GROUNDS RELATING TO YOUR PARTICULAR SITUATION.

IF YOU EXERCISE YOUR RIGHT TO OBJECT, WE WILL CEASE PROCESSING THE DATA UNLESS WE CAN DEMONSTRATE COMPELLING LEGITIMATE GROUNDS THAT OVERRIDE YOUR INTERESTS, RIGHTS AND FREEDOMS, OR IF THE PROCESSING SERVES TO ESTABLISH, EXERCISE OR DEFEND LEGAL CLAIMS.

IF YOUR PERSONAL DATA IS PROCESSED FOR DIRECT MARKETING PURPOSES, YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO OBJECT AT ANY TIME TO SUCH PROCESSING.

IF YOU EXERCISE THIS RIGHT, WE WILL STOP PROCESSING YOUR DATA FOR DIRECT MARKETING PURPOSES.

## 7) Duration of Storage of Personal Data

The storage period for personal data depends on the applicable legal basis, the purpose of processing, and—if relevant—statutory retention periods.

Where processing is based on your consent (Art. 6 (1) lit. a GDPR), your data will be stored until you withdraw your consent.

For data processed under Art. 6 (1) lit. b GDPR in the context of contractual obligations, the data will be stored in accordance with statutory retention periods and deleted thereafter unless continued storage is necessary for contract fulfilment or we have a legitimate interest in continued retention.

For processing under Art. 6 (1) lit. f GDPR, data is stored until you exercise your right to object, unless we can demonstrate overriding legitimate grounds or the processing serves legal claims.

For direct marketing purposes under Art. 6 (1) lit. f GDPR, data is retained until you object in accordance with Art. 21 (2) GDPR.

Unless otherwise specified in this policy, personal data will be deleted when it is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected or otherwise processed.
