

# Privacy Policy

**Last updated:** 28 October 2025

This Privacy Policy explains how **PixelPlex** (“we”, “us”) handles information when you use **CC View** (the Canton network block explorer, website, and APIs).

**Plainly:** we don’t sell your data, we don’t run ads, and we collect only what’s needed to run CC View securely and reliably.

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## 1) Who we are

**Operator/Controller:** PixelPlex and its affiliates

**Product:** CC View — a public block explorer and developer/API tooling for the Canton network.

**Trademark note:** Canton is a trademark of Digital Asset (Switzerland) GmbH. CC View is not affiliated with or endorsed by Digital Asset.

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## 2) What this policy covers

- ccview domains and subdomains
- CC View APIs and SDKs
- Optional account features (e.g., “Sign in with Google”)
- Support requests you send us

This policy does not cover third-party sites you visit from links on CC View.

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### **3) Information we collect (minimal)**

We design CC View to work with as little personal data as possible.

#### **A) If you**

##### **sign in**

##### **(optional)**

- Basic identifiers from your provider (e.g., Google): name, email, account ID, avatar (if provided).
- Session data: sign-in time, session token/identifier.
- Your settings in CC View (e.g., saved watchlists, labels, preferences).

We use Google sign-in only for authentication to CC View features. We do not use OAuth data for advertising or contact lists.

#### **B) When you**

##### **use the site or API**

- Standard server logs: IP address, user-agent, pages or endpoints requested, timestamps, error codes.
- Local storage/cookies: strictly necessary items (session, language/theme, consent choice).

#### **C) Support**

- What you send us (message content, screenshots, your email).

#### **D) Public blockchain data**

- CC View indexes and displays public ledger data from the Canton network (e.g., transactions, validator info). This data is public by design and is not created by us.
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## 4) How we use information

- Provide CC View features (auth, preferences, saved items).
- Keep the service secure and reliable (fraud/abuse prevention, rate-limiting, diagnostics).
- Operate and improve APIs (uptime, debugging, capacity planning).
- Respond to your support requests.
- Comply with applicable laws when required.

**We do not** sell your data, run ads, or send marketing emails.

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## 5) Legal bases (where applicable)

When privacy laws like the GDPR apply, we rely on:

- **Contract** – to provide CC View features you request.
  - **Legitimate interests** – security, service reliability, product improvement with minimal data.
  - **Consent** – for optional cookies/telemetry (turned off unless you opt in).
  - **Legal obligation** – when the law requires it.
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## 6) Sharing

We keep sharing to a minimum. We may share limited data with:

- **Service providers** that host or help us run CC View (e.g., cloud hosting, authentication). They must protect data and act only on our instructions.
- **Authorities** if we're legally required to.

- **Successors** if our business is reorganized, under the same protections.

We don't share data for advertising or cross-site marketing.

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## 7) Retention

- **Account data:** kept while your account is active; deleted or anonymized within **30 days** after you delete your account (subject to legal requirements and short-term backups).
  - **Server/API logs:** typically **30–180 days** for security and reliability.
  - **Support emails:** up to **24 months** for context and audit.
  - **On-chain data:** public by design and cannot be altered or deleted by us.
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## 8) Your choices & rights

- You can sign out at any time; you can delete your account in settings or by emailing us.
- Depending on your location, you may have rights to access, correct, delete, or export personal data, and to object or restrict certain processing.
- Contact [privacy@ccview.io](mailto:privacy@ccview.io) to exercise rights. We'll respond as required by law.

**CCPA/CPRA (California):** we do not “sell” or “share” personal information as defined by law.

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## 9) Cookies & local storage

We use only what's necessary to run CC View (session, preferences, consent). Optional analytics/telemetry—if introduced—will be off by default and controlled by your consent.

You can block cookies in your browser; essential cookies may be required for sign-in.

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## 10) Security

We use reasonable administrative, technical, and organizational measures (encryption in transit, access controls, least-privilege, monitoring). No system is perfectly secure, but we work to protect your information.

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## 11) Children

CC View is a technical tool aimed at general audiences and professionals. It is **not directed to children**, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from anyone under 16. If you believe a minor provided personal data, contact us and we will remove it.
