Local Law No. 10 of the Year 2026

**A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF PORT CHESTER,
CHAPTER 319, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, TO: 1. REPEAL ARTICLE VII,
COMMUTER PARKING; 2. REPEAL CHAPTER 319-88, SCHEDULE XXVII:
COMMUTER PARKING; AND 3. REMOVE THE RELATED FEES IN SECTION 175-4,
ENUMERATION OF FEES**

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Port Chester, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1: Purpose and Intent

Currently, Chapter 319, “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article VII, “Commuter Parking” of the Code of the Village of Port Chester combined with Section 319-88, Schedule XXVII, sets forth the process and rules by which a resident of the Village may apply for and obtain a parking decal from the Office of the Village Clerk to park in the parking lots on either side of the Port Chester (MTA Metro North) train station. However, since 2009, LAZ Parking has been MTA Metro North’s designated parking operator for this purpose. Accordingly, to bring the Code up to date, Article VII, “Commuter Parking” and Section 319-88, Schedule XXVII, “Commuter Parking” must be repealed, and all related fees

SECTION 2: The Code of the Village of Port Chester is hereby amended as follows:

1. Article VII, “Commuter Parking”, of Chapter 319 “Vehicles and Traffic”, IS DELETED IN ITS ENTIRETY; and
2. Section 319-88, Schedule XXVI: “Commuter Parking” IS DELETED IN ITS ENTIRETY; and
3. Chapter 175, “Fees”, Section 175-4, “Enumeration of Fees” is amended to remove the following (delete all stricken text):

SECTION 3. Severability.

In the event any court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional. The court’s order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of thus local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or position

or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

SECTION 4. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
