Local Law No. 11 of the Year 2026

**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF PORT CHESTER
CHAPTER 319-76, SCHEDULE XV: PARKING PROHIBITED CERTAIN TIMES, TO
ADD THE PORT CHESTER-RYE BROOK PUBLIC LIBRARY PARKING LOT TO
THE SCHEDULE**

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Port Chester, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1: Purpose and Intent

Pursuant to New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law Section 1640-a, the legislative body of a Village may, by local law, prohibit, regulate, restrict or limit the parking of vehicles in a parking area owned by a not-for-profit corporation pursuant to a written request of such corporation. The Board Trustees of the Village of Port Chester has been advised that the Port Chester-Rye Brook Public Library, a not-for-profit corporation, has requested in writing that the Port Chester Police Department enforce the parking restrictions of its parking lot during certain days and times.

SECTION 2:

The Code of the Village of Port Chester, Chapter 319-76, Schedule XV: Parking Prohibited Certain Times, is hereby amended to add the following:

Port Chester-Rye Brook Public Library Parking Lot	n/a	All day (24 hours) Sundays and holidays and 10:00 p.m.-6:00 a.m. Monday through Saturday	Entire lot

SECTION 3: Severability.

In the event any court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional. The court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or position or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

SECTION 4: Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
